SURVEY SAYS...

44% of respondents (up 13% from 2016) reported in the last 12 months there being at least one crash involving a moving vehicle at a highway work zone they operate.



25% (39% increase from 2016) reported construction worker injuries at the crash

11% (83% increase from 2016) reported construction worker fatalities at the crash



Nearly 9 OUT 01 IU of respondents believe work zone motor vehicle crashes are a very serious or serious potential safety hazard*

More than 3 0UT 0T 4 still feel motor vehicle crashes are a greater risk today than they were a decade ago.
