






1. By what percentage has your firm's headcount changed in the past 12 months? Responses: 335




2. Do you currently have an open hourly craft or salaried position? Responses: 277 Salaried; 302 Craft




4. How many unfilled hourly craft or salaried positions did you have on June 30, 2024? Responses: 332 Salaried; 308 Craft




5. If your firm is having trouble filling <u>salaried</u> positions, please indicate all the position types you are having trouble filling (Mark all that apply)






7. If you are having trouble filling positions, what are the reason(s)? (Mark all that apply) Responses: 335




8. Has your firm added or increased use of the following to acquire workers in the past 12 months? (Mark all that apply) Responses: 334




9. Has your firm made changes in hiring, training or scheduling in the past 12 months? (Mark all that apply) Responses: 325




10. What techniques, if any, have you implemented to upskill employees? (Mark all that apply) Responses: 324














