




2025 Construction Outlook Oregon Survey Results








9. If projects were postponed or canceled, what was the main reason? (mark all that apply) Responses: 22






11. What challenges, if any, do you see regarding the safety and health of your firm's workers? (mark all that apply) Responses: 25











16. Does your firm use cloud-hosted technology in any of the following ways (mark all that apply)? Responses: 30




